What is the Nova Scotia Place Names Database?

The Nova Scotia Place Names Database is the authoritative source for locations and spelling of all places in Nova Scotia.

What's in a name?

With cultural influences over many centuries — English, Irish, Scottish, French, German, Aboriginal, and African, to name just a few—Nova Scotia has become noted for the history and diversity of its many destinations. All geographic places within the province, such as towns, counties, rivers, lakes, hills, and valleys, have distinct names, and it is vital that one consistent and accurate source contains their official information.

The Nova Scotia Place Names Database is the official reference for every place name within the province. Exact locations, historical roots, establishment dates, distinct features, name evolutions, and proper spellings (called "uniform nomenclature") are catalogued, managed, and maintained in the place names database.
