40 Nova Scotia Active Control Stations (NSACS) are now in place across the Province. The stations allow for real-time, centimeter level positioning across our province using an internet connection and precise GPS receivers. - **CVG69710.gsb grid shift file now available**

A grid shift file has been developed by NRCan to transform GIS data layers from NAD83(CSRs) 1997.0 to NAD83(CSRs) 2010.0. This file will facilitate the Province's migration to the newer realization of NAD83.
