



COORDINATE REFERENCING NEWS - December 2016

Nova Scotia survey community embraces the Province's modernized Coordinate Referencing System

The **Association of Nova Scotia Land Surveyors** recently agreed to reference all new survey plans to the Nova Scotia Coordinate Referencing System, NAD83 (CSRS)2010.0 and CGVD2013.

The migration effort will bring an unprecedented level of repeatability to future survey work in the Province, and aligns with Nova Scotia's continued efforts to create an infrastructure that provides higher accuracy and better accessibility for land related measurements.

This is an important step in the Province's continued efforts to modernize the underlying infrastructure, particularly as it relates to property, and allows for all geographic information in Nova Scotia to be represented in a global coordinate system.

Nova Scotia's survey community transition to the NSCRS network becomes effective December 31st, 2017.
